AN ORDINANCE of the City of Troy, Illinois amending Chapter 92 to include the identification of shared-use path in the City of Troy, Illinois

ADOPTED BY THE CITY COUNCIL
OF THE CITY OF TROY, ILLINOIS
THIS 21ST DAY OF JANUARY 2025

Whereas, the City Council of the City of Troy, Madison County, Illinois wishes to promote pedestrian and bicycle travel within the city limits of Troy; and

Whereas, the City Council of the City of Troy, Madison County, Illinois, wishes to provide a safe opportunity for pedestrians and bicyclist to traverse within the city; and

Whereas, the anticipated pedestrian and bicyclist volume will increase as more shared-use paths are added to the city's infrastructure; and

Whereas, upon order of the City Council of the City of Troy, Illinois and the evidence herein established, the City Engineer has determined the need to improve safety throughout the corporate limits of the City of Troy, Madison County, Illinois.

Whereas, the City Council of the City of Troy, Madison County, Illinois wishes to promote pedestrian and bicycle travel within the city limits of Troy; and

Whereas, the City Council of the City of Troy, Madison County, Illinois, wishes to provide a safe opportunity for pedestrians and bicyclist to traverse within the city; and

Whereas, upon order of the City Council of the City of Troy, Illinois and the evidence herein established, the City Engineer has determined the need to improve safety throughout the corporate limits of the City of Troy, Madison County, Illinois.

Now, Therefore, Be It Ordained by the Mayor and the City Council of the City of Troy, Illinois as follows:

SECTION 1: The preamble of this Ordinance is hereby incorporated herein by reference, the same as if set forth in this Section of this Ordinance verbatim, as findings of the City Council of the City of Troy, Illinois.

SECTION 2: Chapter 92 of the Code of Ordinances for the City of Troy shall add Section 012, which shall read as follows:

Any sidewalk within the city, which is 8' or greater in width, shall be considered a shared-use path. Such sidewalk shall accommodate pedestrian, bicycle (to include e-bikes) and other non-motorized methods of movement.

SECTION 3: That if any section or provision of this Ordinance is declared invalid for any reason, such invalidity shall not affect or impair any of the remaining sections or provisions of this Ordinance which can be given effect without the invalid section or provision, and to this end, the sections and provisions of this Ordinance are declared to be severable.

SECTION 4: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval as provided by law and shall be published in pamphlet form by the authority of the City Council.

PASSED by the City Council of the City of Troy, Madison County, Illinois, approved by the Mayor, and deposited in the office of the City Clerk this 20th day of January 2025.
