(Addendum 2 to IDOT Jurisdictional Transfer Form)

**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE JURISDICTIONAL TRANSFER
OF A CERTAIN HIGHWAY FROM MADISON COUNTY TO THE
CITY OF TROY**

(FROM THE NORTH EDGE OF PAVEMENT OF N. KIMBERLIN STREET AND
NORTHEASTERLY .63 MILES TO THE BEGINNING OF FAS 780 INCLUDING SN
060-33379 IN ITS ENTIRETY; AND FROM THE END OF FAU 9392
NORTHEASTERLY .25 MILES TO A POINT 268 FT NORTH OF THE CENTERLINE
OF OAKLAND DRIVE IN ITS ENTIRETY; AND FROM THE WEST EDGE OF
PAVEMENT OF STAUNTON ROAD SOUTHERLY .29 MILES TO WEST EDGE OF
PAYMENT OF STATUNTON ROAD/CH 21 IN ITS ENTIRETY)

THIS SECOND DAY OF JUNE, 2025

WHEREAS, Section 7-101 of the Illinois Highway Code (605 ILCS 5/7-101) authorizes a municipality to make changes to its municipal street system; and

WHEREAS, Section 4-409 of the Illinois Highway Code (605 ILCS 5/4-409) authorizes any local highway authority, with the approval of the Illinois Department of Transportation (IDOT), to enter into a written contract with any other highway authority for the jurisdiction, maintenance, administration, engineering, or improvement of any highway or portion thereof, and

WHEREAS, Madison County has jurisdiction over a certain portion of Staunton Road to include:

- 1) 0.63 Miles of Staunton Road (CH 21/FAU 9392) Termini being from north edge of pavement of N Kimberlin Street northerly and northeasterly .63 miles to the beginning of FAS 780 including SN 060-3379, in its entirety.
- 2) 0.25 Miles of Staunton Road (CH 21/FAS 780) Termini being from end of FAU 9392 northeasterly .25 miles to a point 268 ft north of the centerline of Oakland Drive, in its entirety.
- 3) 0.29 Miles of Old County Highway 21 (TR 279B) Termini being from west edge of pavement of Staunton Road southerly .29 miles to west edge of pavement of Staunton Road/CH 21 in its entirety.

WHEREAS, the City is willing to accept jurisdiction over said portions of Staunton Road and Old County Highway 21 as noted above; and

WHEREAS, Madison County, IDOT, and the City must execute a Local Agency Agreement for Jurisdictional Transfer before the transfer of the aforementioned portion of roads from the Madison County street system to the City's street system can occur; and

WHEREAS, Madison County, IDOT, and the City desire to enter into such Local Agency Agreement for Jurisdictional Transfer as herein provided; and

WHEREAS, the City Council, after due consideration, finds that accepting jurisdiction over these portions of roadway in their entirety is in the best interests of the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the City and is further desirable for the welfare of the City's government and affairs.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Troy, Illinois, as follows:

Section 1. The Local Agency Agreement for Jurisdictional Transfer between Madison County, the Illinois Department of Transportation, and the City of Troy, Illinois, in substantially the form of the copy of said Agreement attached hereto and hereby incorporated by reference, be and the same is hereby authorized and approved.

Section 2. The Mayor of the City of Troy, Illinois, is hereby authorized to execute and deliver, and the City Clerk of the City of Troy, Illinois, is hereby authorized to attest to said execution of said Agreement as so authorized and approved for and on behalf of the City of Troy, Illinois.

Section 3. The following three sections of roadway are hereby accepted, and jurisdiction is hereby transferred to the City of Troy, Illinois, to be part of, and incorporated into, the City of Troy's municipal street system, effective July 1, 2025:

- 1) 0.63 Miles of Staunton Road (CH 21/FAU 9392) Termini being from north edge of pavement of N Kimberlin Street northerly and northeasterly .63 miles to the beginning of FAS 780 including SN 060-3379, in its entirety.
- 2) 0.25 Miles of Staunton Road (CH 21/FAS 780) Termini being from end of FAU 9392 northeasterly .25 miles to a point 268 ft north of the centerline of Oakland Drive, in its entirety
- 3) 0.29 Miles of Old County Highway 21 (TR 279B) Termini being from west edge of pavement of Staunton Road southerly .29 miles to west edge of pavement of Staunton Road/CH 21 in its entirety

Section 4. This Ordinance shall not be construed to affect any suit or proceeding pending in any court, or any rights acquired, or a liability incurred, or any cause or causes of action acquired or existing prior to the effective date of this Ordinance; nor shall any right or remedy of any character be lost, impaired, or affected by this Ordinance.

Section 5. Upon approval of this Ordinance, the City Clerk is directed to transmit four signed originals, including addendums, to Adam Walden, Madison County Engineer, who will deliver appropriate copies to the IDOT Region 8 office.

Section 6. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.

Section 7. This Ordinance is hereby passed by the affirmative vote, the “ayes” and “nays” being called, of a majority of the members of the Council of the City of Troy, Illinois, at a meeting of said Council.




WHEREAS, the Illinois Compiled Statutes Chapter 605 article 5/5-105 grants to the County the authority to make changes to the County Highway System.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the County Board of Madison County that the Chairman of the County Board be and is hereby authorized to sign a Local Agency Agreement for Jurisdictional Transfer in behalf of Madison County deleting a portion of Staunton Road (0.83 Miles) and Old County Highway 21 (0.29 Miles) from the County Highway System, subject to the approval of the Illinois Department of Transportation.

(Addendum 2 to IDOT Jurisdictional Transfer Form)

**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE JURISDICTIONAL TRANSFER
OF A CERTAIN HIGHWAY FROM MADISON COUNTY TO THE
CITY OF TROY**

(FROM THE NORTH EDGE OF PAVEMENT OF N. KIMBERLIN STREET AND
NORTHEASTERLY .63 MILES TO THE BEGINNING OF FAS 780 INCLUDING SN
060-33379 IN ITS ENTIRETY; AND FROM THE END OF FAU 9392
NORTHEASTERLY .25 MILES TO A POINT 268 FT NORTH OF THE CENTERLINE
OF OAKLAND DRIVE IN ITS ENTIRETY; AND FROM THE WEST EDGE OF
PAVEMENT OF STAUNTON ROAD SOUTHERLY .29 MILES TO WEST EDGE OF
PAYMENT OF STATUNTON ROAD/CH 21 IN ITS ENTIRETY)

ADOPTED BY THE CITY COUNCIL
OF THE CITY OF TROY, ILLINOIS
THIS SECOND DAY OF JUNE, 2025

WHEREAS, Section 7-101 of the Illinois Highway Code (605 ILCS 5/7-101) authorizes a municipality to make changes to its municipal street system; and

WHEREAS, Section 4-409 of the Illinois Highway Code (605 ILCS 5/4-409) authorizes any local highway authority, with the approval of the Illinois Department of Transportation (IDOT), to enter into a written contract with any other highway authority for the jurisdiction, maintenance, administration, engineering, or improvement of any highway or portion thereof, and

WHEREAS, Madison County has jurisdiction over a certain portion of Staunton Road to include:

- 1) 0.63 Miles of Staunton Road (CH 21/FAU 9392) Termini being from north edge of pavement of N Kimberlin Street northerly and northeasterly .63 miles to the beginning of FAS 780 including SN 060-3379, in its entirety.
- 2) 0.25 Miles of Staunton Road (CH 21/FAS 780) Termini being from end of FAU 9392 northeasterly .25 miles to a point 268 ft north of the centerline of Oakland Drive, in its entirety.
- 3) 0.29 Miles of Old County Highway 21 (TR 279B) Termini being from west edge of pavement of Staunton Road southerly .29 miles to west edge of pavement of Staunton Road/CH 21 in its entirety.

WHEREAS, the City is willing to accept jurisdiction over said portions of Staunton Road and Old County Highway 21 as noted above; and

WHEREAS, Madison County, IDOT, and the City must execute a Local Agency Agreement for Jurisdictional Transfer before the transfer of the aforementioned portion of roads from the Madison County street system to the City's street system can occur; and

WHEREAS, Madison County, IDOT, and the City desire to enter into such Local Agency Agreement for Jurisdictional Transfer as herein provided; and

WHEREAS, the City Council, after due consideration, finds that accepting jurisdiction over these portions of roadway in their entirety is in the best interests of the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the City and is further desirable for the welfare of the City's government and affairs.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Troy, Illinois, as follows:

Section 1. The Local Agency Agreement for Jurisdictional Transfer between Madison County, the Illinois Department of Transportation, and the City of Troy, Illinois, in substantially the form of the copy of said Agreement attached hereto and hereby incorporated by reference, be and the same is hereby authorized and approved.

Section 2. The Mayor of the City of Troy, Illinois, is hereby authorized to execute and deliver, and the City Clerk of the City of Troy, Illinois, is hereby authorized to attest to said execution of said Agreement as so authorized and approved for and on behalf of the City of Troy, Illinois.

Section 3. The following three sections of roadway are hereby accepted, and jurisdiction is hereby transferred to the City of Troy, Illinois, to be part of, and incorporated into, the City of Troy's municipal street system, effective July 1, 2025:

- 1) 0.63 Miles of Staunton Road (CH 21/FAU 9392) Termini being from north edge of pavement of N Kimberlin Street northerly and northeasterly .63 miles to the beginning of FAS 780 including SN 060-3379, in its entirety.
- 2) 0.25 Miles of Staunton Road (CH 21/FAS 780) Termini being from end of FAU 9392 northeasterly .25 miles to a point 268 ft north of the centerline of Oakland Drive, in its entirety
- 3) 0.29 Miles of Old County Highway 21 (TR 279B) Termini being from west edge of pavement of Staunton Road southerly .29 miles to west edge of pavement of Staunton Road/CH 21 in its entirety

Section 4. This Ordinance shall not be construed to affect any suit or proceeding pending in any court, or any rights acquired, or a liability incurred, or any cause or causes of action acquired or existing prior to the effective date of this Ordinance; nor shall any right or remedy of any character be lost, impaired, or affected by this Ordinance.

Section 5. Upon approval of this Ordinance, the City Clerk is directed to transmit four signed originals, including addendums, to Adam Walden, Madison County Engineer, who will deliver appropriate copies to the IDOT Region 8 office.

Section 6. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.


Section 7. This Ordinance is hereby passed by the affirmative vote, the “ayes” and “nays” being called, of a majority of the members of the Council of the City of Troy, Illinois, at a meeting of said Council.
