**AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING LIMITATIONS OF USE FOR MUNICIPAL
OFF-STREET PARKING LOTS OWNED BY THE CITY OF TROY, ILLINOIS**

WHEREAS, the City of Troy, Illinois (the “City”), is a non-home rule municipality organized and existing under the laws of the State of Illinois; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to 65 ILCS 5/11-71 and related provisions of the Illinois Municipal Code, the City has the authority to regulate the use of municipal property, including the designation, regulation, and control of municipal parking facilities; and

WHEREAS, the City owns and operates certain off-street parking lots intended for public use in support of municipal buildings, downtown businesses, and community activities; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council of the City of Troy find that establishing defined limitations of parking for municipal off-street parking lots is necessary to promote public safety, prevent unauthorized overnight parking, protect public property, and ensure orderly use of City facilities;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Troy, Madison County, Illinois, as follows:

SECTION 1. PURPOSE.

The purpose of this Ordinance is to establish uniform limitations of operation for designated City-owned off-street parking lots in order to regulate parking activity, deter nuisance conditions, and support safe and efficient municipal operations.

SECTION 2. APPLICABILITY AND DESIGNATED PARKING LOT.

This Ordinance shall apply to the following City-owned off-street parking lots as designated by the Mayor and City Council.

SECTION 3. PARKING LIMITATIONS

There shall be no overnight parking on parking lots owned and operated by the City of Troy.

SECTION 4. EXCEPTIONS.

These restrictions shall not apply to City-authorized vehicles, emergency vehicles, or vehicles authorized by permit or written authorization of the City.

SECTION 5. SIGNAGE.

The City shall post signage identifying permitted parking hours. Once posted, lack of awareness shall not be a defense.

SECTION 6. ENFORCEMENT AND PENALTIES.

Violations of this Ordinance shall be subject to fines of not less than \$25.00 and not more than \$500.00, and vehicles may be towed at the owner's expense.

SECTION 7. SEVERABILITY.

If any portion of this Ordinance is found invalid, such invalidity shall not affect remaining provisions.

SECTION 8. REPEALER.

All ordinances in conflict herewith are repealed to the extent of such conflict.

ORDINANCE NO. 2000 - 19

**AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING CERTAIN PARKING RESTRICTIONS FOR
THE CITY PARKING AREA ADJACENT TO THE DR. DON SPENCER, D.V.M.
MEMORIAL PARK IN THE CITY OF TROY, ILLINOIS**

WHEREAS, the City of Troy, Madison County, Illinois has heretofore established certain no parking zones and parking restrictions to promote pedestrian and vehicular safety on the streets and thoroughfares of the City of Troy; and

WHEREAS, based on a review conducted by the City of Troy, the City has determined that the creation of additional parking restrictions will further enhance pedestrian and vehicular safety within the corporate limits of the City of Troy; and

WHEREAS, the City of Troy believes it is in the best interest of the City and its citizens to establish certain parking restrictions on parking areas adjacent to the Dr. Don Spencer, D.V.M. Memorial Park.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TROY, MADISON COUNTY, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the City Council hereby determines that the preambles hereto are true and correct and are incorporated herein by reference as if fully set forth at this point.

Section 2. A new Section 14-80 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Troy is hereby added by adding the following parking restrictions to be in effect on the parking area adjacent to the Dr. Don Spencer, D.V.M. Memorial Park located at the corner of Center Street and Kimberlin Street;

(a) It shall be unlawful for any person to park any vehicle on the City parking area located at the corner of Center Street and Kimberlin Street between the hours of 10:00 p.m. and 6:00 a.m.

(b) It shall be unlawful for any person to park at any time a second division vehicle, as defined by the Illinois Vehicle Code, on the City parking area located at the corner of Center Street and Kimberlin Street.

Section 3. Any violation of this Section shall be punishable by a fine of not less than Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) and not more than Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00).

Section 4. The foregoing restrictions shall be set forth on parking signs conforming to the Illinois Department of Transportation's Sign Manual and Specifications. The location of these signs shall conform to the same requirements of the Illinois Department of Transportation's Sign Manual and Specifications.

Section 5. If any section or provision of this Ordinance is declared invalid for any reason, such invalidity shall not affect or impair any of the remaining sections or provisions of this Ordinance which can be given effect without the invalid section or provision, and to this end, the sections and provisions of this Ordinance are declared to be severable.


Section 6. This Ordinance shall be effective upon its passage, signing and publication as required by law.
