ORDINANCE 2024 – 55

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF TROY, ILLINOIS, DESIGNATING WYNONA ST. AS ONE-WAY

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Troy, Madison County, Illinois, wishes to provide a safe opportunity for traffic to navigate Wynona St.

WHEREAS, the addition of the Tri-Township Park Trail Extension are warranted cause for one-way traffic designation; and

WHEREAS, 625 ILCS 5/11-708 One-way roadways and rotary traffic islands. (a) The Department and local authorities, with respect to highways under their respective jurisdictions, may designate any highway, roadway, part of a roadway or specific lanes upon which vehicular traffic shall proceed in one direction at all or such times as shall be indicated by official traffic control devices.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Troy, Illinois has determined that the public safety will be promoted by establishing One-Way Traffic at the locations set forth by the Chief of Police.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TROY, MADISON COUNTY, ILLINOIS AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section 1.</u> That the City Council hereby determines that the preambles hereto are true and correct and are incorporated herein by reference as if fully set forth at this point.



<u>Section 2.</u> One-Way Traffic is hereby required and shall be installed as follows:

One-Way Traffic on Wynona St. from Laundry St. to Sarah St.

<u>Section 3.</u> Do Not Enter Signs conforming to the Illinois Department of Transportation's standards and specifications, if applicable, shall be erected on Wynona St. at Sarah St. of Troy, Illinois. The location of these signs shall conform to the requirements of the Illinois Department of Transportation's standards and specifications, if applicable.

<u>Section 4.</u> Any person who disobeys the Do Not Enter signs to be placed pursuant to this Ordinance shall be in violation of Chapters 71.07 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Troy, and shall be in violation of our Codified Ordinances, and shall be fined not less than \$25.00 nor more than \$500.00 for each suchoffense.

<u>Section 5.</u> The Code of Ordinances of the City of Troy, Illinois, Chapter 73, Schedule VII, is hereby created to reflect the above described One-Way Traffic designation.

<u>Section 6.</u> If any section or provision of this Ordinance is declared invalid for any reason, such invalidity shall not affect or impair any of the remaining sections or provisions of this Ordinance which can be given effect without the invalid section or provision, and to this end, the sections and provisions of this Ordinance are declared to be severable.

<u>Section 7.</u> This Ordinance shall be in full force and affect from and afterits passage and approval and publication in pamphlet, according to thelaw.



<u>Section 4.</u> Any person who disobeys the Do Not Enter signs to be placed pursuant to this Ordinance shall be in violation of Chapters 71.07 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Troy, and shall be in violation of our Codified Ordinances, and shall be fined not less than \$25.00 nor more than \$500.00 for each suchoffense.

<u>Section 5.</u> The Code of Ordinances of the City of Troy, Illinois, Chapter 73, Schedule VII, is hereby created to reflect the above described One-Way Traffic designation.

<u>Section 6.</u> If any section or provision of this Ordinance is declared invalid for any reason, such invalidity shall not affect or impair any of the remaining sections or provisions of this Ordinance which can be given effect without the invalid section or provision, and to this end, the sections and provisions of this Ordinance are declared to be severable.

<u>Section 7.</u> This Ordinance shall be in full force and affect from and afterits passage and approval and publication in pamphlet, according to the law.
