RESOLUTION 2022-19**


FAIR HOUSING RESOLUTION

- WHEREAS, the City of Troy of Madison County, Illinois, finds that the economic stability of the city directly depends upon stable, integrated, and balanced patterns; and
- WHEREAS, it further finds that stable and integrated and balanced living patterns are threatened by discriminatory acts and unlawful housing practices; and
- WHEREAS, it further finds that discriminatory acts and unlawful housing practices contribute to the formation and preservation of segregated neighborhoods thereby affecting the quality of daily life of the citizens of the city; and
- WHEREAS, it further finds that discriminatory acts and unlawful housing practices interfere with the achievement of stable, integrated and balanced living patterns, thereby depriving the citizens of the benefits of interracial, interreligious and intercultural association.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and the City Council of Troy, Illinois as follows:

1. That the findings hereinabove stated are hereby incorporated by reference and made a part of Resolution.
2. The discriminatory and unlawful housing practices as defined by the Department of Housing and Urban Development pursuant to the Community Block Grant Regulations, are hereby specifically against the policy and practices of the City of Troy, Illinois to participate in or allow the expenditure of government funds for housing projects which are not consistent with HUD rules and regulations.
