WHEREAS, the City of Troy completed a "Bicycle and Pedestrian Master Plan" in which the city conducted a resident survey, where city residents identified extending the Silver Creek Trail to Triad High School as one of its top priorities; and

WHEREAS, extending the shared use path from Henning Elementary School to Triad High School will provide a safe path of travel for pedestrians and cyclists.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of Troy, Illinois, supports Jarvis Township's ITEP grant application in this matter; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Troy, Illinois, hereby authorizes the Mayor to sign a letter of support for this grant application.

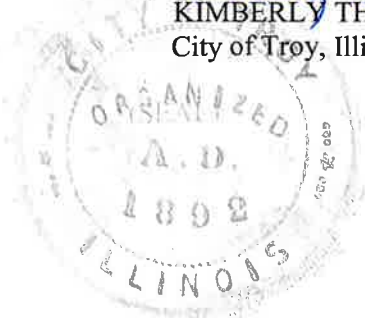

The City of Troy offers its full support for Jarvis Township's grant application for Illinois Transportation Enhancement Program Cycle 15 (ITEP) funding for extending the shared-use path along US 40 from CA Henning Elementary School to Triad High School. The city believes the extension of this shared-use path is an important connection within the region's trail system.

In June 2022, the City of Troy completed a "Bicycle and Pedestrian Master Plan" in which the city conducted a resident survey. The City's residents identified extending the Silver Creek Trail to Triad High School as one of its top priorities. As such, the Township's grant application supports our residents' strong desire for the trail to extend easterly from the city limits to Triad High School.
