WHEREAS, 5 ILCS 120, paragraph 2.06 (as amended) of the Open Meetings Act requires that a public body meet every six months, or as soon as practicable, to review the minutes of closed sessions and determine whether said minutes must remain closed or may be opened to public review; and

WHEREAS, the minutes of all closed sessions held through September 30, 2023, were reviewed by the Troy City Council on October 2, 2023; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that all or portions of the minutes of some closed sessions should be divulged, and that all or portions of the minutes of some closed sessions should remain confidential.


