

CITY OF TROY RESOLUTION 2025-02
RESOLUTION OF SUPPORT AND COMMITMENT OF LOCAL FUNDS
(TAP Grant - Shared-Use Path on Troy O'Fallon Road)

WHEREAS, the City of Troy, Illinois, is applying to East West Gateway Council of Governments for a **Transportation Alternatives Program Grant (TAP)**, to add an 8'-wide shared-use path from Turtle Creek Drive to Meadowbrook Drive/ Fair Oaks Drive on the west side of Troy O'Fallon Road, and

WHEREAS, this section of improvements is Phase 2 of the project, as Madison County Transit already constructed an 8'-wide shared-use path from US 40 to Turtle Creek Drive on the west side of Troy O'Fallon Road, and

WHEREAS, this section of shared-use path will improve connections to the Fair Oaks, Meadowbrook and Turtle Creek subdivisions to Madison County Transit's Silver Creek Trail, and

WHEREAS, this section of shared-use path was identified as the #1 priority by the public and listed as a priority route in the City of Troy's adopted "Bicycle and Pedestrian Master Plan", and

WHEREAS, it is necessary that an application be made and agreements be entered into with the State of Illinois Department of Transportation, and

WHEREAS, cost of the project are such that financial participation by the grantee is necessary in conjunction with TAP funds.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED as follows:

- 1) That the City apply for a grant under the terms and conditions of the East West Gateway Council of Governments and shall enter into and agree to the understandings and assurances contained in said application.
- 2) That the Mayor, City Treasurer, and City Administrator on behalf of the City may execute such documents and all other documents necessary for the carrying out of said application.
- 3) That the Mayor, City Treasurer, and City Administrator are authorized to provide such additional information as may be required to accomplish the obtaining of such grant.
- 4) That the City of Troy, Illinois does hereby commit funds in the amount of about \$250,000 for use in conjunction with a TAP Grant, for an estimated total project cost of about \$750,000 with the final amount to be determined during grant preparation.

PASSED by the City Council of the City of Troy, Madison County, Illinois, approved by the Mayor, and deposited in the office of the City Clerk this 21st day of January 2025.
