PUBLIC NOTICE – Amendment to Ordinances

Effective 62 days after this publication the following changes will be effective:

91.44 Duty to cut (A) change from six inches to eight inches.

91.46 Enforcement (F) Assessment of costs. All expenses of such cutting, to include equipment usage, transportation, man-hours involved, and overhead, including any and all cost incurred in the removal or relocation of debris, junk or other miscellaneous obstructions which would be necessary or convenient to carry out the requirements of this subchapter shall be paid by the owners of such land, thereof per residential parcel, per cutting. If the township mows a property, the Township shall bill to the property owner \$250.00 dollars for the first hour and \$25 dollars for each hour after foe each employee for mowing. After having a lot mowed, the township shall then submit a bill to the property owner for the cost of the mowing. If the property owner does not pay the bill within 60 days of the date of the invoice, the cost of such payment shall be charged against the premises and it shall become a lien on the land or property assessed of the same character in effect as the lien created by general law for taxes.

90.20 Add in Definitions under Abandon vehicles: *Unregistered vehicles*. *Includes, without limitation, any motor vehicle, vessel or trailer which would normally be registered to operate on state highway or public waters*.

90.22 add Unregistered vehicle to the heading to read: 90.22 STORAGE OR ACCUMULATION OF TRASH, RUBBISH, JUNK, JUNK VEHICLES, ABANDONED VEHICLES AND UNREGISTERED VEHICLES. VESSELS AND TRAILERS

Change first paragraph in 90.22 to read: It shall be unlawful for any person to store, or permit the storage or accumulation of trash, rubbish, junk, junk vehicles, abandon vehicles or unregistered vehicles, vessels and trailers on private property, except...
