ANNUAL TAX LEVY ORDINANCE

AN ORDINANCE FOR THE LEVY OF TAXES FOR TAX YEAR 2024
FOR THE VILLAGE OF WELDON, IN DeWITT COUNTY, ILLINOIS

WHEREAS, the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Weldon, in DeWitt County, Illinois, heretofore adopted an Annual Appropriation Ordinance for the Village of Weldon, for the fiscal year commencing on the 1st day of May, A.D., 2024, and ending on the 30th day of April, A.D., 2025, which said Ordinance was duly approved by the President and the Board of Trustees of said Village, and duly published as required by law.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Weldon, in DeWitt County, Illinois, at a regular meeting duly assembled:

SECTION 1: GENERAL CORPORATE FUND. That the sum of SIX THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED SIXTY-FIVE DOLLARS AND NO CENTS (\$6,865.00) be and IT IS HEREBY LEVIED upon all taxable property (including railroad property) within said Village of Weldon, as the same is assessed and equalized for the following specific purposes mentioned in the said appropriation ordinance and the respective amounts as follows, and said taxes shall be extended and collected in accordance with the provisions of the statute in such case made and provided, for the items and the amounts enumerated as follows, to-wit:

1. General Corporate Fund

SECTION 2: INSURANCE FUND. That the sum of SIXTEEN THOUSAND TWO HUNDRED SEVENTY-FIVE DOLLARS (\$16,275.00) BE AND IT IS HEREBY LEVIED upon all taxable property (including railroad property) within said Village of Weldon, as the same is assessed and equalized for the following specific purposes mentioned in the said appropriation ordinance and in the respective amounts as follows, and said taxes shall be extended and collected in accordance with the provisions of 745 ILCS 10/9-107 for the items and the amounts enumerated as follows, to-wit:

1. Insurance Fund	<u>\$ 16,275.00</u>

SECTION 3: AUDIT FUND. That the sum of SEVEN THOUSAND THIRTY-FIVE DOLLARS (\$7,035.00) BE AND IT IS HEREBY LEVIED upon all taxable property (including railroad property) within said Village of Weldon, as the same is assessed and equalized for the following specific purposes mentioned in the said appropriation ordinance and in the respective amounts as follows, and said taxes shall be extended and collected in accordance with the provisions of 50 ILCS 310/9 for the items and the amounts enumerated as follows, to-wit:

1. Audit Fund	<u>\$ 7,035.00</u>

SECTION 4: SOCIAL SECURITY FUND. That the sum of SIX THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED TWENTY-FIVE DOLLARS (\$6,825.00) BE AND IT IS HEREBY LEVIED upon all taxable property (including railroad property) within said Village of Weldon, as the same is assessed and equalized for the following specific purposes mentioned in the said

appropriation ordinance and in the respective amounts as follows, and said taxes shall be extended and collected in accordance with the provisions of 40 ILCS 5/21-110 for the items and the amounts enumerated as follows, to-wit:

1. Employer's contribution to Social Security Fund	<u>\$ 6,825.00</u>

SECTION 5: IMRF FUND. That the sum FOURTEEN THOUSAND SEVEN HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$14,700.00) BE AND IT IS HEREBY LEVIED upon all taxable property (including railroad property) within said Village of Weldon, as the same is assessed and equalized for the following specific purposes mentioned in the said appropriation ordinance and in the respective amounts as follows, and said taxes shall be extended and collected in accordance with the provisions of 65 ILCS 5/11-81-2 for the items and the amounts enumerated as follows, to-wit:

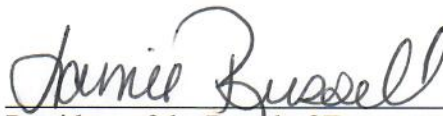

SECTION 6: That the total amount of property tax for all corporate purposes, legally, made to be collected by tax levy for the current fiscal year, is the sum of **FIFTY-ONE THOUSAND SEVEN HUNDRE DOLLARS AND NO CENTS (\$51,700.00)**.

SECTION 7: That a duly certified copy of this Ordinance shall be filed with the County Clerk of DeWitt County, Illinois as is provided by law.

SECTION 8: That this Ordinance shall be known as the "Annual Tax Levy Ordinance for Tax Year 2024 for the Village of Weldon, in DeWitt County, Illinois", and shall be in full force and effect from and after its adoption, passage and approval.
