RESOLUTION

Whereas, the Marion County Commission has reviewed the Fairmont Municipal Airport expansion plans, and received public input from the citizens who have concerns regarding the proposed plan and,

Whereas, the expansion plan proposes to displace 32 homes and a number of neighboring mobile home residents and is inconsistent with a residential neighborhood and,

Whereas, the airport is a general aviation airport with no commercial passenger carriers and,

Whereas, the airport was relocated due to the construction of Interstate 79 because it was deemed subordinate to the Interstate System and did not warrant the rerouting the interstate alignment and,

Whereas, the County Commission has not seen significant evidence that the airport is commercially beneficial to the community and,


Whereas, the airport's existing location could be better suited for the development of the high technology corridor, which is continuing to be developed in Marion County.

Now, therefore be it resolved that the Marion County Commission opposes this project in its present form and this resolution is to serve as notice to the Federal Aviation Administration, the Fairmont/Marion County Regional Airport Authority, the residents of Marion County and other interested parties of their opposition to the proposed plan. 
