



FAIR HOUSING RESOLUTION

Whereas, the Town Council of White Hall desires to give meaning to the guarantees of equal rights contained in the Constitution and laws of this State and the United States, and to encourage and bring about mutual self-respect and understanding among all citizens and groups in its boundaries; and,

Whereas, under the Federal Fair Housing Law, Title VIII of the Civil Rights Act of 1968, it is illegal to deny housing to any person because of race, color, religion, sex, or national origin; and,

Whereas, under the West Virginia State Fair Housing Law, Title 49-2-305, MCA, it is illegal to deny housing to any person because of race, sex, religion, color, age, physical or mental handicap or national origin;

Therefore, be it resolved the Town of White Hall, West Virginia makes a firm commitment to do all within its power to eliminate prejudice, intolerance, disorder and discrimination in housing.

Therefore, be it also resolved that a Fair Housing Law poster, which has the "Equal Housing Opportunity" logo, will be displayed at Town Hall.

Therefore, be it also resolved that the following procedures will be used to accomplish the purpose of the aforementioned resolution:

- 1. The Town of White Hall shall inform all Town employees of the Town's commitment to fair housing.*
- 2. The Town of White Hall will post this resolution on the Town's bulletin boards and other public places and publicize it.*
- 3. The Town of White Hall shall direct all employees to forward immediately to the Mayor any reports they receive of housing discrimination.*
- 4. The Mayor shall forward such complaints to the West Virginia Human Rights Commission, 1321 Plaza East, Room 108A, Charleston, West Virginia, 25301-1400, within 10 days of receipt of said complaint.*
