

**RESOLUTION 14- 002**

Town of White Hall, West Virginia

**A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF WHITE HALL, A WEST VIRGINIA MUNICIPAL CORPORATION, AUTHORIZING THE CONVERSION OF THE TOWN PAVILION INTO THE TOWN POLICE DEPARTMENT**

**WHEREAS**, the Council Members of the Town of White Hall applied in 2008 for a Grant from the State of West Virginia for the construction of a municipal park and the Town Pavilion to be made in the Town of White Hall; and

**WHEREAS**, the Town of White Hall was awarded a Grant from the State of West Virginia Development Office Community Participation Program and used the funds to construct a park and pavilion for use by the citizens of the Town of White Hall; and

**WHEREAS**, over the years the pavilion has not received significant use or rental by the citizens of the Town and a public need exists for the development of a fixed location to house the Town of White Hall Police Department; and

**WHEREAS**, because of the limited space available on Town property the only feasible location in which to construct the Town Police Department is in the present location of the municipal park and Town Pavilion;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF WHITEHALL AS FOLLOWS:**


Section 1. BEST INTERESTS OF THE TOWN. It is hereby found and determined that it is the best interest for the citizens and residents of the Town of White Hall to construct a new municipal police station in the present park and pavilion location;


Section 2. It is in the best interests of the citizens and residents of the Town of White Hall to use the present pavilion structure and modify it as needed to construct a new police station;

Section 3. AUTHORIZATION. The Mayor and other officers of the Town who shall have power to execute contracts and perform other acts on behalf of the Town, and each of them hereby is, authorized to execute, acknowledge and deliver any required documents with which may be required to manage the conversion of the present municipal park and pavilion to the municipal police station.

Section 4. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Resolution shall take effect immediately.
