

RESOLUTION NO. 15-005

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN OF WHITE HALL APPOINTING NEW MEMBERS TO THE TOWN OF WHITE HALL BUILDING COMMISSION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF WHITE HALL, WEST VIRGINIA

WHEREAS, the Town of White Hall, West Virginia, is a municipal corporation recognized under the statutes of the State of West Virginia; and

WHEREAS, the Town of White Hall by Ordinance No. 04-002 created, appointed and empowered the Town of White Hall Building Commission; and

WHEREAS, the appointments of the Commissioners have expired; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the Town of White Hall must appoint new Building Commissioners;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the Council for the Town of White Hall does hereby appoint the following persons as Commissioners whose names and tenure of office shall be as follows:

1. Tim Ridenour, who is hereby appointed for a term of two years commencing January 1, 2016, and ending January 1, 2018.
2. Thomas Denniston, who is hereby appointed for a term of three (3) years commencing January 1, 2016, and ending January 1, 2019.


As the tenure of each of the foregoing appointees shall expire, the successor to fill the vacancy created by such expired tenure shall be appointed for a term of three years by the Town Council and, thereafter, successors shall likewise be appointed for terms of three years by the Town Council.

In accordance with said Ordinance, no more than two thirds of the total number of members of the Board of such Building Commission shall be from the same political party and no member of such Board shall hold any office (other than the office of notary public) or employment under the United



States of America, the State of West Virginia, any county or political subdivision thereof, or any political party. All members of such Board shall be residents of the Town of White Hall. No member of such Board shall receive any compensation for his or her services as such, but each member shall be reimbursed by such Building Commission for any reasonable and necessary expenses actually incurred in the discharge of his or her duties as a member of the Board.
