

RESOLUTION 16- 008

Town of White Hall, West Virginia

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF WHITE HALL, A WEST VIRGINIA MUNICIPAL CORPORATION, AUTHORIZING THE DEVELOPMENT OF AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT WITH THE MARION COUNTY PARKS AND RECREATION COMMISSION FOR DEVELOPMENT OF A CONVENTION CENTER/RECREATION FACILITY

WHEREAS, the Council Members of the Town of White Hall ("Town") have determined that a need may exist for a convention center and recreation facility in the Town of White Hall; and

WHEREAS, the Town has taken preliminary steps in conjunction with the Marion County Parks and Recreation Commission ("MCPARC") to explore locations and conceptual designs for such facilities; and

WHEREAS, the Marion County Parks and Recreation Commission shares similar interests with the Town in the development and completion of such facilities; and

WHEREAS, the Town is agreeable to moving forward with a resolution to partner with MCPARC to more fully develop this proposal and determine the feasibility of constructing a convention center and recreation facility.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF WHITEHALL AS FOLLOWS:

The Mayor and/or his designees are hereby authorized to move forward on behalf of the Town with the development of the appropriate intergovernmental agreements with the Marion County Parks and Recreation Commission to begin the "5G" Process (WV Code 5G-1-1, et seq.) to acquire an architect/engineer for the development of a convention center/recreation facility and to conduct a feasibility study to determine the impact of a such a facility as part of the architect/engineer tasks. It is the intent of Council that all costs incurred for such work shall be shared equally with MCPARC and that the Town's share of such costs shall be appropriate paid from funds generated by the hotel occupancy tax.

EFFECTIVE DATE. This Resolution shall take effect immediately.
