

RESOLUTION 17-006

**A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF WHITE HALL,
WEST VIRGINIA RE-APPOINTING GREG S. MASON TO THE TOWN OF WHITE
HALL BUILDING COMMISSION**

WHEREAS, the Town of White Hall, West Virginia, is a municipal corporation recognized under the statutes of the State of West Virginia; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council of the Town of White Hall (the "Council") has created, by Ordinance, a Town of White Hall Building Commission (the "Commission") and vested it with certain authority as prescribed by law; and

WHEREAS, by Resolution the Council previously appointed Greg S. Mason to the Commission; and


WHEREAS, the previous appointment of Mr. Mason to the Commission has expired; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the Town of White Hall desires to re-appoint Mr. Mason to another term on the Commission;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the Council of the Town of White Hall, West Virginia does hereby re-appoint Greg S. Mason for another term on the Commission.


In accordance with Ordinance 17-005 and state law, no more than two thirds of the total number of members of the Board of such Building Commission shall be from the same political party and no member of such Board shall hold any office (other than the office of notary public) or employment under the United State of America, the State of West Virginia, and county or political subdivision thereof, or any political party. All members of such Board shall be residents of the Town of White Hall. No member of such Board shall receive any compensation for his or her services as such, but each member shall be reimbursed by such Building Commission for any reasonable and necessary expenses actually incurred in the discharge of his or her duties as a member of the Board.
