

RESOLUTION 18- 002

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF WHITE HALL, A WEST VIRGINIA MUNICIPAL CORPORATION, AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION AND DELIVERY OF AN EMPLOYMENT AGREEMENT FOR TOWN COORDINATOR

WHEREAS, the Council Members of the Town of White Hall have determined that a true and very real need exists to retain the services of a Town Coordinator; and

WHEREAS, the Town has taken the necessary steps to meet with and negotiate its agreement with a prospective Town Coordinator; and

WHEREAS, the Town proposes to enter into an Employment Agreement substantially in the form presented in this meeting with Cindy Bates; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE TOWN OF WHITE HALL AS FOLLOWS:


Section 1. BEST INTERESTS OF TOWN. It is hereby found and determined that the terms of this Agreement in the form presented to this meeting and incorporated in this resolution are in the best interests of the Town for employing its Town Coordinator.

Section 2. AUTHORIZATION. The Agreement is hereby approved. The Mayor of the Town of White Hall and other officers of the Town who shall have power to execute contracts on behalf of the Town be, and each of them hereby is, authorized to execute, acknowledge and deliver the Agreement, such approval to be conclusively evidenced by such execution and delivery of the Agreement. The Mayor or Recorder of the Town and any other officers of the Town who shall have power to do so be, and each of them hereby is, authorized to affix the official seal of the Town to the Agreement and attest the same.


Section 3. EXECUTION OF DOCUMENTS. The proper officer(s) of the Town be, and each of them hereby is, authorized and directed to execute and deliver any and all papers, instruments, opinions, certificates, affidavits, and other documents and to do or cause to be done any and all other acts and things necessary or proper for carrying out this resolution and the Agreement.

Section 4. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Resolution shall take effect immediately.
