

RESOLUTION 18-006

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF WHITE HALL, A WEST VIRGINIA MUNICIPAL CORPORATION, AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENGAGE IN DISCUSSIONS WITH TRI-COUNTY WATER ASSOCIATION

WHEREAS, the Council Members of the Town of White Hall have determined that a true and very real need exists to widen an existing waterline from Crabapple Lane down Sapps Run to the intersection of Vineyard Lane and Cypress Lane for the purpose of installing a fire hydrant; and

WHEREAS, the Town desires to engage in discussions with Tri-County Water Association to remedy its need for a widened waterline and installation of a fire hydrant at the intersection of Vineyard Lane and Cypress Lane; and

WHEREAS, the Town proposes to enter into said discussions with the Mayor acting on behalf of the Council; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE TOWN OF WHITE HALL AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. BEST INTERESTS OF TOWN. It is hereby found and determined that the widening of said waterline is in the best interest of the Town for providing services to its citizens.

Section 2. AUTHORIZATION. The Mayor of the Town of White Hall shall have power to enter into discussions on behalf of the Town of White Hall for the purpose of extending said waterline.

Section 3. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Resolution shall take effect immediately.
