

RESOLUTION 18- 008

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF WHITE HALL, A WEST VIRGINIA MUNICIPAL CORPORATION, AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENGAGE IN NEGOTIATIONS WITH HUFFMAN CORPORATION

WHEREAS, the Town of White Hall is in the process of renovating and constructing a new Public Service Building; and

WHEREAS, the Town has requested bids for the construction and renovation of said Public Service Building; and

WHEREAS, Huffman Corporation of Bridgeport, West Virginia was the lowest responsive bidder; and

WHEREAS, said bid from Huffman Corporation of Bridgeport, West Virginia exceeds the Town's current bond amount; and


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE TOWN OF WHITE HALL AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. BEST INTERESTS OF TOWN. It is hereby found and determined that negotiating and entering into a contract with Huffman Corporation of Bridgeport, West Virginia below the amount of funds available is in the best interest of the Town of White Hall.


Section 2. AUTHORIZATION. The Mayor of the Town of White Hall shall have power to enter into further negotiations with Huffman Corporation of Bridgeport, West Virginia and enter into a contract with said company for the Phase I renovation and construction of the new White Hall Municipal and Public Safety Building only if said bid does not exceed Two Million Six Hundred Thirteen Thousand Dollars (\$2,613,000.00).

Section 3. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Resolution shall take effect immediately.
