

PROPOSITION NO. 4

Public Ownership of Transbay Bridge

September 12, 1927.

Honorable Election Commission,
City and County of San Francisco.

Gentlemen: Your attention is called to the following resolution adopted by the Board of Supervisors on Monday, August 29, 1927:

Resolution No. 27754 (New Series):

“RESOLVED, That any transbay bridge from the City and County of San Francisco to the County of Alameda shall be financed, constructed, maintained and operated under public ownership, and that the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco shall take such steps as may be necessary for such construction, operation and ownership of said bridge; and be it

“FURTHER RESOLVED, That the foregoing declaration of policy be submitted to the electors of the City and County of San Francisco, for their approval or disapproval, at the general municipal election to be held Tuesday, November 8, 1927.”
