TEXT OF PROPOSED DECLARATION OF POLICY PROPOSITION J

DESCRIBING AND SETTING FORTH A
DECLARATION OF POLICY TO THE QUALIFIED ELECTORS OF THE CITY AND
COUNTY OF SAN FRANCISCO AT AN
ELECTION TO BE HELD THEREIN ON
JUNE 2, 1992, RELATING TO THE QUESTION OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF SAN
FRANCISCO BEING A PART OF THE STATE

OF NORTH CALIFORNIA, IN THE EVENT THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA IS DIVIDED INTO TWO STATES.

BE IT MOVED, The San Francisco Board of Supervisors, pursuant to Charter Section 9.108, sets forth the following declaration of policy to be submitted to the qualified electors of the City and County of San Francisco at an election to be

held on June 2, 1992:

Shall it be the policy of the City and County of San Francisco, in the event the State of California were divided into a northern California state and a southern California state, for San Francisco to be part of the northern California state?
