

CHAPTER EIGHTEEN  
STREETS AND SIDEWALKS

PART

PROVIDING FOR THE OPENING, LAYING OUT AND  
ADOPTION OF PARK ALLEY OF THE BOROUGH OF  
YOE, YORK COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA.

An Ordinance providing for the opening, laying out and adoption of Park Alley of the Borough of Yoe, York County, Pa., from the center line of East Third Street, south to the Borough limits, as a public highway of said Borough of Yoe, and designating the width of said highway.

SECTION 1. Be it enacted and ordained by the Chief Burgess and Town Council of the Borough of Yoe, York County, Pa., and it is hereby enacted and ordained by authority of the same:

That Park Alley be and the same is hereby opened, laid out and adopted as a public highway of the Borough of Yoe aforesaid, of the uniform width of twenty feet, the following courses and distances, to wit: Beginning for the center line thereof in the center of East Third Street, and extending thence south 13 degrees, east twenty minutes, a distance of four hundred and twenty feet to the Borough limits.
