

PROVIDING FOR THE OPENING, LAYING OUT  
AND ADOPTION OF EAST FOURTH STREET OF  
THE BOROUGH OF YOE, YORK COUNTY, PA.

An Ordinance providing for the opening, laying out and adoption of East Fourth Street of the Borough of Yoe, York County, Pa., from the center line of Main Street east to the Eastern line of Park Alley as a public highway of said Borough of Yoe, and designating the width of said highway.

SECTION 1. Be it enacted and ordained by the Chief Burgess and Town Council of the Borough of Yoe, York County, Pa., and it is hereby enacted and ordained by authority of the same;

That East Fourth Street be and the same is hereby opened, laid out and adopted as a public highway of the Borough of Yoe aforesaid, of the uniform width of 30 feet (from curb to curb) the following courses and distances, to wit: Beginning for the center thereof at a point in the center of Main Street, and extending thence south seventy nine degrees, east thirty-two minutes, a distance of four hundred and seventy feet to the eastern line of Park Alley.
