AN ORDINANCE TO INCREASE THE INDEBTEDNESS  
OF YOE BOROUGH, YORK COUNTY, PA., BY THE  
SUM OF NINE THOUSAND DOLLARS FOR THE  
PURPOSE OF IMPROVING THE HIGHWAY KNOWN AS  
MAIN STREET.

An Ordinance signifying the desire of the corporate authorities of the Borough of Yoe, York County, Pa., to increase the indebtedness of said borough by the sum of nine thousand dollars (\$9,000.00) for the purpose of improving the highway of said borough known as Main Street, by the grading, macadamizing and repairing of said street, and the construction of bridges and culverts thereon and paying the borough's share of the cost of said improvement: providing for the holding of an election in said borough to obtain the assent of the electors of said borough to said increase of indebtedness, and authorizing the corporate authorities of said borough to make the necessary announcements of said election to the electors of said borough, and to do all other acts and things incident thereto.

SECTION 1. Be it enacted and ordained by the Chief Burgess and Town Council of the Borough of Yoe, York County, Pa., and it is hereby enacted and ordained by authority of the same: That the corporate authorities of said borough hereby signify and express their desire to make an increase of indebtedness of the Borough of Yoe, York County, Pa., in the sum of nine thousand dollars (\$9,000.00) for the purpose of grading macadamizing and repairing Main Street of said borough, and the construction of bridges and culverts thereon, the said amount of none thousand dollars (\$9,000.00) exceeding two per centum but not exceeding seven per centum of the last preceding assessed valuation of taxable property of Yoe Borough, York County, Pa.

SECTION 2. That for the purpose of obtaining the assent of the electors of said Borough of Yoe, York County, Pa., to the increase of indebtedness of said borough in the sum of nine thousand dollars (\$9,000.00) for the purpose of improving Main Street of said borough by the grading, macadamizing, repairing of said street, and the construction of bridges and culverts thereon, and paying the borough's share of the cost of said improvement, a public election shall be held throughout said borough, in pursuance of the Act of Assembly approved April 20, 1874, P. L. 65, and all amendments and supplements of said Act of Assembly applicable thereto, at the usual place of holding municipal elections, on the ninth day of December A. D. 1924, during the hours prescribed by law for holding elections. Notice of said election shall be given by the corporate authorities of said borough during at least thirty days prior to said election by twenty printed handbills posted in the most public places

in said borough (no newspapers being published therein), which said notice shall contain a statement of the amount of the last preceding assessed valuation; of the amount of the existing debt; of the amount and percentage of the proposed increase, and the purpose for which the indebtedness is to be increased; and it shall be the duty of the proper authorities having charge of the preparation of the necessary official ballots to have prepared and distributed said necessary ballots, as provided by law governing such increase of indebtedness having the question such increase of indebtedness printed upon said ballots in brief form and followed by the words "Yes" and "No", as provided by the Act of Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania applicable thereto, as follows:

Shall the bonded indebtedness of the Borough of Yoe, York County, Pa., be increased by the additional sum of nine thousand dollars (\$9,000.00) for the purpose of improving the highway of said borough known as Main Street, by grading, macadamizing, and repairing said highway, and the construction of bridges and culverts thereon, and paying the borough's share of the cost of said improvement?
