

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE RUNNING OF RAILROAD CARS AND LOCOMOTIVES OR EITHER OR ANY OF THEM WITHIN THE LIMITS OF THE BOROUGH OF YOE: DEFINING THE MAXIMUM SPEED OF SAID CARS AND LOCOMOTIVES OR EITHER OR ANY OF THEM: REGULATING THE STANDING OF LOCOMOTIVES AND CARS OR EITHER OR ANY OF THEM ON ANY STREET OR ON ANY INTERSECTION OF ANY RAILROAD WITH ANY STREET WITHIN THE LIMITS OF SAID BOROUGH AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION OF ANY OF THE PROVISIONS OF THIS ORDINANCE.

Be it enacted and ordained by the Chief Burgess and Town Council of the Borough of Yoe and it is hereby enacted and ordained by the authority of the same.

SECTION 1. It shall not be lawful for any engineer or other person in charge of or in control of any railroad locomotive, railroad car or cars or either or any of them within the limits of the Borough of Yoe, to operate, run or move said locomotive, car or cars or either or any of them within the limits of said Borough at a greater rate of speed than Fifteen miles per hour.

SECTION 2. It shall not be lawful for any engineer or other person in charge of or in control of any railroad locomotive, railroad car or cars or either or any of them, to allow or permit such railroad locomotive, railroad car or cars or either or any of them, to stand upon any street or upon the intersection of said railroad with any street within said Borough of Yoe, at any one time for a longer period of time than Five minutes.

SECTION 3. Any person who shall violate any of the provisions of this ordinance, shall, upon conviction thereof, before any Alderman or Justice of the Peace of York County, Pennsylvania, forfeit any pay a sum not exceeding Ten Dollars for the use of said Borough of Yoe, the same to be recovered in the name of the Commonwealth for the use of said Borough as such penalties are by law recoverable. In default of payment of said penalty, the person so convicted shall be committed to the jail of said York County for a period of one day for each dollar of penalty so imposed.

Authorizing the making of a loan of eight hundred dollars for the payment of the cost of certain permanent improvements, to wit: erecting and constructing bridges and culverts; for the payment of amount due the fire department of said borough; and for the payment of the purchase price of the Emmanuel Hartman property; authorizing the issuing of the bond of said borough as evidence of said indebtedness; fixing the rate of interest, and creating a sinking fund for the redemption of said bond.

SECTION 1. Be it enacted and ordained by the Chief Burgess and Town Council of the Borough of Yoe, Pa., and it is hereby enacted and ordained by authority of the same, That the Chief Burgess, President and Secretary of Council be and are hereby authorized, empowered and directed to borrow in the name of the Borough of Yoe, Pa., the sum of eight hundred dollars, and as evidence of such indebtedness to issue a bond in the amount of said loan, which said bond shall be dated December 1, 1911, signed by the Chief Burgess and President of Council attested by the Borough Secretary, and shall have the seal of the Borough affixed thereto. Said bond shall be payable in eight years from the date thereof and redeemable, at the option of the said borough, in one year from the date thereof, and shall bear interest at the rate of five per cent per annum, payable semi-annually; said borough to have the privilege of paying at least one hundred dollars annually, on account of the principal thereof.

SECTION 2. For the purpose of creating a sinking fund for the redemption and payment of said bond and the interest and state tax thereon, as the same shall become due, there shall be annually levied and assessed, and there is hereby levied and assessed upon the taxable property within the Borough of Yoe, Pa., an annual tax as follows: for the year 1912, the sum of one hundred and forty three dollars and twenty cents; for the year 1913, the sum of one hundred and thirty seven dollars and eighty cents; for the year of 1914, the sum of one hundred and thirty two dollars and forty cents; for the year 1915, the sum of one hundred and twenty seven dollars; for the year 1916, the sum of one hundred and twenty one dollars and sixty cents; for the year 1917, the sum of one hundred and sixteen dollars and twenty cents; for the year 1918, the sum of one hundred and ten dollars and eighty cents; for the year 1919, the sum of one hundred and five dollars and forty cents.

SECTION 3. Said sum so borrowed shall be used and is hereby appropriated for the following purposes, to wit:

Four hundred dollars thereof for the purpose of paying the cost of certain permanent improvements, to wit, erecting and constructing bridges culverts; two hundred and fifty dollars for the payment of balance due the fire department; one hundred and fifty dollars for the payment of the purchase price of the Hartman property, which is hereby authorized and directed to be purchased for the use of said borough.
