

CHAPTER EIGHTEEN
STREETS AND SIDEWALKS

PART

ORDINANCE NO. 16 - 1894

RELATING TO THE DIGGING OF HOLES AND
DITCHES IN THE STREETS IN THE BOROUGH
OF YOE, YORK COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA.

SECTION 1. Be it enacted and ordained by the Chief Burgess and Town Council of the Borough of Yoe, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by authority of the same, That if any person or persons, body corporate by their servants or agents, shall dig any hole or ditch in any of the streets or alleys of said Borough, it shall be the duty of said person or persons or corporate to fill up the said hole or ditch by puddling the ground, and if any stone shall be taken up by replacing the same on top, so as to restore the street to as good a condition as before the digging of said hole or ditch, and in case of their neglect or refusal to do so after receiving notice, the street committee of said Borough shall cause the same to be done in manner aforesaid, and the person or persons or body corporate so offending, shall forfeit and pay the cost and charges incurred, thereby, together with a fine of Five Dollars, which costs, charges and fines shall be collected and appropriated as other charges and fines due the Borough are collected and appropriated.
