

AMENDING AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING AND FIXING
THE WIDTH OF HIGH STREET, EAST OF NORTH HIGH
STREET, IN THE BOROUGH OF YOE, YORK COUNTY,
PENNSYLVANIA, APPROVED THE 15TH DAY OF
DECEMBER, A.D. 1894.

ORDINANCE NO. 2 - 1927.

Amending an ordinance establishing and fixing the width of High Street, east of north High Street, in the Borough of Yoe, York County, Pennsylvania, approved the 15th day of December, A. D. 1894.

SECTION 1. Be it enacted and ordained by the Council of the Borough of Yoe, York County, Pa., and it is enacted and ordained by authority of the same: That Section 1 of an ordinance establishing and fixing the width of High Street, east of North High Street, in the Borough of Yoe, York County, Pa., which reads as follows: "Beginning for the centre line thereof at a stone planted in the middle of Main Street -- thence south forty-one degrees and forty-six minutes -- east one hundred and eighty-five and seven-tenths feet to a stone at the intersection of Myrtle Alley -- thence on the same course two hundred and thirty-four and seven-tenths feet to a stone at the intersection of Howard Alley -- said street to be of a uniform width of forty feet with a side walk five feet wide on each side, making the entire width of said street and side walks fifty feet, be amended so as to read as follows:

SECTION 1. That that portion of High Street running eastward of North High Street be and the same is hereby established as a public highway of the Borough of Yoe, York County, Pa., as follows: Beginning for the centre line thereof at a stone planted in the middle of Main Street of said Borough, and extending thence south forty-one degrees and forty-six minutes, east one hundred and eighty-five and seven-tenths feet to a stone at the intersection of Myrtle Alley; thence on the same course, two hundred and thirty-four and seven-tenths feet to a stone at the intersection of Howard Alley; said street to be of a uniform width of thirty-eight feet, with a sidewalk five feet wide on each side, making the entire width of street and sidewalks forty-eight feet.
