

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH COUNCIL OF YOE BOROUGH
ESTABLISHING CERTAIN NO PARKING RESTRICTIONS ON THE EAST SIDE OF
SOUTH ELM STREET

ORDINANCE NO. 2003 - 09

WHEREAS, South Elm Street is a duly adopted Borough Street; and

WHEREAS, Borough Council, in its charge to adequately protect the general health, safety, and welfare of the Citizens of Yoe Borough, has determined that certain parking restrictions should be placed on South Elm Street; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with the Borough Code, the Borough has sought the advice of the York County Planning Commission by formally requesting a traffic and engineering study; and

WHEREAS, a traffic and engineering study was conducted by the York County Planning Commission which recommended that the Borough adopt the no parking proposed on South Elm Street.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED, AND IT IS HEREBY ENACTED AND ORDAINED BY THE BOROUGH COUNCIL OF BOROUGH OF YOE, YORK COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AS FOLLOWS:


1. No parking will be allowed on the east side of South Elm Street starting at a position forty (40) feet from the intersection of South Elm Street and Third Street in the Borough of Yoe to the intersection.
2. The Borough shall post appropriate no parking signs designating the above area as a no parking zone.
3. Fines and penalties shall be as set forth in the Code of Ordinances for no parking throughout the Borough.

4. By enacting this Ordinance, the Borough hereby repeals any and all Ordinances heretofore adopted which are inconsistent herewith.




