

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A PARKING RESTRICTIONS ON
NORTH AND SOUTH MAIN STREET IN THE
BOROUGH OF YOE

ORDINANCE NO. 2004 - 03

not adopted

WHEREAS, as part of its charge to protect the general health, safety, and welfare of the Citizens of Yoe Borough, Borough Council of Yoe Borough is authorized from time-to-time to govern parking on Borough Streets; and

WHEREAS, Borough Council of the Borough of Yoe has determined that for the benefit of the health safety, and welfare of the Citizens of Yoe Borough, that no parking restrictions be authorized on North and South Main Street beginning at the North Borough line and terminating at the South Borough line on both sides of the street; and

WHEREAS, Yoe Borough Council has requested that the York County Planning Commission examine the proposal of the Borough; and

WHEREAS, the York County Planning Commission has recommended that the Borough Plan can be implemented.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED, AND IT IS HEREBY ENACTED AND ORDAINED AS FOLLOWS:

1. A no parking zone is established on both sides of North and South Main Street beginning at the North Borough line and terminating at the South Borough line.
2. Borough Council or its designee is hereby authorized to install appropriate signage posting North and South Main Street as a no parking area.
3. Signage shall be spaced evenly throughout the zone.


4. Borough Council hereby revokes any and all prior Ordinances inconsistent herewith.


5. Penalties for violation of this Ordinance shall be in accordance with Local Ordinances and the Motor Vehicle Code.


