

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A HANDICAPPED PARKING
FACILITY AT 211 SOUTH MAIN STREET IN THE
BOROUGH OF YOE

ORDINANCE NO. 2004 - 04

WHEREAS, as part of its charge to protect the general health, safety, and welfare of the Citizens of Yoe Borough, Borough Council of Yoe Borough is authorized from time-to-time to govern parking on Borough Streets; and

WHEREAS, Borough Council of the Borough of Yoe is desirous of establishing a handicapped parking space at 211 South Main Street; and

WHEREAS, the matter has been reviewed by the York County Planning Commission and a recommendation has been made that a handicapped parking space at 211 South Main Street should be established.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED, AND IT IS HEREBY ENACTED AND ORDAINED AS FOLLOWS:

1. A handicapped parking spot is created at 211 South Main Street. Borough Council or its designees are hereby authorized to erect any appropriate signage to confirm and designate the handicapped parking space.
2. The Borough or its designee, may paint the area of the parking space a dark blue, if deemed appropriate by Borough Council.
3. By adopting this Ordinance, Borough Council hereby revokes any and all Ordinances and regulations inconsistent herewith.

4. Fines to be imposed shall be in accordance with applicable Borough Codes and the Pennsylvania Motor Vehicle Code.
