Ordinance No. 2021-02

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF YOE, YORK COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA,
AMENDING CHAPTER 1, PART 4, OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE
BOROUGH OF YOE TO REFLECT THE TRANSITION FROM YOE FIRE COMPANY
TO THE SOUTHERN AREA FIRE AND EMERGENCY RESCUE**

WHEREAS, an ordinance was adopted by the Borough of Yoe on February 6, 1990, and codified as Chapter 1, Part 4, §1-401 *et. seq.*, which officially recognized the Yoe Fire Company No. 1 as the officially recognized fire company of the Borough; and

WHEREAS, a merger of the Yoe Fire Company No.1. and the Rescue Fire Company No. 1 has been effectuated to create the entity now named the Southern Area Fire and Emergency Rescue; and

WHEREAS, it has come to the attention of the Yoe Borough Council that the Part 4 (Yoe Borough Fire Company) must be amended to reflect the change in the entity currently providing fire, rescue and emergency services.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED, by the Borough Council of the Borough of Yoe, York County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby ordained and enacted, in lawful session assembled, that Chapter 1, Part 4 be amended as follows:

**Part 4
Yoe Borough Fire Company**

A. Recognized

§ 1-401. Fire Company Recognized.

The Yoe Fire Company No. 1 Southern Area Fire and Emergency Rescue (a/k/a "SAFER", and hereinafter referred to as the "Fire Company"), organized and existing in the Borough of Yoe, York County, Pennsylvania, is hereby designed as the officially recognized Fire Company for the Borough of Yoe. Any reference to either the Yoe Fire Company No. 1, or any derivative thereof, found in the Yoe Borough Code of Ordinances (including, but not limited to: §1-411; §1-412; §1-413; §7-103; §7-202; §7-203; §7-204; §7-207; §7-301; §7-302; §7-311; §7-502; §7-511; §7-512; §24-401; §24-402; §24-403 and §24-404) or any other reference to the provision of fire services set forth in the Yoe Borough Code of Ordinances shall hereafter mean, and be interpreted to mean the provision of such services by the Southern Area Fire and Emergency Rescue (a/k/a "SAFER"), or any subsequent entity tasked by Yoe Borough with the duty of providing fire services to Yoe Borough.

§ 1-402. Authorized Activities of the Fire Company.

1. The Fire Company recognized by the Borough is hereby authorized to provide such services to the Borough as may be necessary for the protection of property and persons situate therein, which include, by way of example and not limitation, the extinguishment and prevention of loss of life and property from fire, automobile accidents, medical emergencies, hazardous materials incidents, and other dangerous situations.

2. The Fire Company may also provide nonemergency and public service functions, such as, again by way of example and not of limitation, removing water from property after storms, and assisting in the removal, abatement and prevention of damage or injury to persons or property, whether through natural causes of man-made situations.

3. The Fire Company may also conduct and participate in such training activities and drills, either within or outside of the Borough, as may be deemed necessary by the officers of the Fire Company to maintain proficiency in providing service.

4. The Fire Company may also respond to calls and provide services to municipalities outside of the Borough.

§ 1-403. Authorized Activities of Members of the Fire Company.

In addition to actually participating in the activities of the Fire Company as authorized above, or in going to or returning from any activities, the members of the Fire Company recognized by the Borough are also authorized to do the following:

A. Engage in any type of drill, training, ceremony, practice, test or parade when duly called for or authorized by an officer or officers of the Fire Company.

B. Engage in fundraising activities for the Fire Company, when authorized by an officer or officers of the Fire Company.

C. Engage in the performance of any other duty or activity authorized by any officer of the recognized Fire Company.

D. Engage in emergency management coordination. [Ord. 94-002]


§ 1-404. Purpose.

The purpose of this Part is to recognize that the Fire Company's acts which are classified as public firefighting duties are done on behalf of the Borough, and to state additional authorized activities for firefighters for workers' compensation purposes.
