

AN ORDINANCE REQUESTING THE IMPROVEMENT OF
MAIN STREET, AND AGREEING TO CONTRIBUTE
TO THE COST THEREOF.

ORDINANCE NO. 4 - 1927

An Ordinance requesting the improvement of Main Street, and agreeing to contribute to the cost thereof.

WHEREAS, The Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, by the Secretary of Highways, in conjunction with the County of York and the Borough of Yoe, is about to reconstruct and improve a section of eighteen (18) feet in width, of a certain public road, lying within the Borough of Yoe on Main Street, and

WHEREAS, It is desired to improve within said borough the entire width of said section of public road, description of which is as follows:

From the Dallastown and Yoe Borough line, at Station 22 plus 29.7 to the Yoe Borough-York Township line, at Station 50 plus 09, i. e., Application No. 2794.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That the said Borough of Yoe by its duly authorized officers enter into a contract with the successful contractor providing for the reconstruction of that portion of said Main Street, not covered by the improvement to be made by the State, County and Borough, including all necessary excavation, etc., and that the said officers be authorized to enter into an agreement with the Secretary of Highways on behalf of the Commonwealth providing for such improvement in the manner aforesaid.
