ADOPTION AND EXTENSION OF
EAST PHILADELPHIA STREET.

Entitled An Ordinance to lay out, extend and adopt East Philadelphia Street in the Borough of Yoe, York County, Pennsylvania, from the center of Park Alley to lands of the Citizens Band of Yoe as a public street of said Borough of Yoe.

Be it enacted and ordained by the Chief Burgess and Town Council of the Borough of Yoe in the County of York, Pennsylvania that East Philadelphia Street in said Borough is hereby laid out, extended and adopted as a public street of the said Borough of Yoe, from the center of Park Alley in said Borough to lands of the Citizens Band of Yoe in said Borough of Yoe, as follows: Beginning for the center line thereof, at an iron peg in the center of Park Alley and in the center of said East Philadelphia Street, thence extending South, seventy-seven and one-fourth degrees, East, three hundred and three feet, to an iron peg at line of lands of Citizens Band of Yoe, and of the uniform width of forty (40) feet, that is to say, a width of twenty (20) feet on each side of the center line of said East Philadelphia Street, and subject to a side walk of five (5) feet on each side of said East Philadelphia Street.
