

AN ORDINANCE LAYING OUT AND EXTENDING EAST
MAPLE STREET AND NORTH HIGH STREET, OF THE
BOROUGH OF YOE, YORK COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA.

EAST MAPLE STREET. Beginning for the centre line thereof at an iron peg in the centre of George Street; thence extending North $48\frac{1}{2}$ degrees East one hundred and eighty feet and ten inches to an iron peg in the centre of Gay Alley; thence along same course one hundred and ninety-seven feet and seven inches to an iron peg at the intersection of High street; said Maple street, to be of a uniform width of thirty feet from curb line to curb line, with a sidewalk of five feet on each side thereof, making the entire width of Maple street and sidewalks 40 feet.

WEST HIGH STREET. Beginning thereof at an iron peg in the centre of Main Street; thence extending North $41\frac{3}{4}$ degrees West four hundred and seventy-nine feet and two inches to an iron peg at the intersection of Maple street; said High street to be of a uniform width of forty feet from curb line to curb line, with a five foot sidewalk on both sides of the street, making the entire width of High street and sidewalks 50 feet.
