

AN ORDINANCE

Adopting and opening South Mason Avenue, in the Borough of Yoe, York County, Pennsylvania.

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the mayor and council of the Borough of Yoe, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by the authority of the same, that South Mason Avenue in said borough be adopted and opened between the southern line of South Walnut Street and the southern line of Taylor Avenue, and that said avenue shall have a width of eighteen (18) feet throughout with nine (9) feet on each side of the following described center line, to wit:

BEGINNING at a point on the southern line of West Walnut Street, said point being north four (4) degrees thirty (30) minutes ten (10) seconds east, three hundred fifty-eight and forty one-hundredths (358.40) feet to a point; north forty-two (42) degrees fifty-nine (59) minutes ten (10) seconds west, two hundred fifty-two and ninety-five one-hundredths (252.95) feet to a point, and south forty-five (45) degrees, twenty-one (21) minutes fifty (50) seconds west, twenty (20) feet from the intersection of the northern curb line of West Philadelphia Street, if extended, and the center line of South Elm Avenue; thence along the center line of South Mason Avenue south forty-five (45) degrees twenty-one (21) minutes fifty (50) seconds west, one hundred fifty-five (155) feet to a point on the southern line of Taylor Avenue.
