ORDINANCE NO. 72-001

AN ORDINANCE TO ESTABLISH A FEE FOR
ISSUING APPLICATIONS AND PERMITS IN
THE ENFORCEMENT OF PENNSYLVANIA
SEWAGE FACILITIES ACT OF 1966.

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Board of Yoe Borough Council,
York County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby enacted and ordained as follows:

SECTION 1. From and after the date of this ordinance, it shall be unlawful for any person, firm, association or corporation to erect, construct, alter or extend any sewage disposal system of any kind within the limits of Yoe Borough, York County, Pennsylvania, without first obtaining a permit to do so.

SECTION 2. Applications for permits shall be made to the Borough Engineer or such Enforcement Officer as may be designated by the Yoe Borough Council.

SECTION 3. The Borough Engineer or Enforcement Officer shall issue a permit upon compliance by the applicant with the provisions of the Pennsylvania Sewage Facilities Act of January 24, 1966 P. L. 1535, as amended, and any regulations adopted thereunder.

SECTION 4. A fee in the sum of Ten (\$10.00) Dollars, payable to Yoe Borough, shall be paid at the time of the filing of the application for the construction of a new sewage facility; or repairing an existing system.

SECTION 5. The applicant shall be responsible for costs and expenses of percolation tests and/or back hoe diggings made for Borough Engineer or Enforcement Officer to determine compliance with requirements of the Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Resources.
