ORDINANCE

An Ordinance modifying license fee for Garden Spot Cable Co. License.

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Board of Yoe Borough Council, York County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby enacted and ordained as follows:

SECTION 1. WHEREAS Ordinance No. 67-09 enacted October 4, 1967, provided for a license fee in Section 13.

SECTION 2. WHEREAS the Yoe Borough Council intends and desires to modify Section 13 to read as follows:

SECTION 13. In consideration of the license herein granted, the licensee company agrees to pay and shall pay amount equal to the highest percentage paid annually to the surrounding municipal governments to Yoe Borough but in no event less than 4 % of the proceeds received by licensee in Yoe Borough by virtue of said cable T. V. connections. The first annual fee shall be due and owing on the 2nd day of October, 1973 and on the same date yearly thereafter. Upon failure of the licensee company to make any of the required payments within the time specified, or upon the failure of the licensee company to comply with any other substantive provisions hereof, this license agreement may, at the option of the licensor, become null and void, and all rights and privileges of the licensee company shall cease and terminate.

(The remaining paragraphs of Section 13 shall remain the same and are not modified.)

SECTION 3. All other sections of Ordinance No. 67-09 shall remain in same full force and effect.
