ORDINANCE

An Ordinance regarding Snow and Ice Removal from Sidewalks and Walkways.

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Board of Yoe Borough Council, York County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby enacted and ordained as follows:

SECTION 1. Owner, Occupant or Tenant of Property to Remove Snow and Ice from Sidewalks and Walkways: The owner, occupant or tenant of every property fronting upon or alongside of any of the streets in the Borough of Yoe is hereby required to remove or cause to be removed from all of the sidewalks and walkways in front of or alongside of such property, all snow or ice thereon fallen or formed within twelve (12) hours after the same shall have ceased to fall or to be formed. The snow or ice shall be removed to a width of not less than three (3) feet and shall not be shoveled into gutters, crosswalks or cartways, but shall be placed along the outer or inner edges of the sidewalks or walkways. Provided that snow or ice that has ceased to fall or to be formed after six o'clock of any evening may be removed at any time before eight-thirty o'clock of the next morning. Provided, further, that the owner of a property shall be responsible for conforming to the requirements of this section where such property is occupied by such owner or is occupied by such tenant or occupier thereof, where such property is occupied by such tenant or occupier only; and the owner thereof where the property is a multiple-business or multiple-dwelling property, occupied by more than one tenant or occupier.

SECTION 2. Authority for Borough to Remove Snow and Ice at Expense of Defaulting Owner, Occupant or Tenant. In any case where the owner, occupant or tenant, as aforesaid, shall fail, neglect or refuse to comply with any of the provisions of the first section of this ordinance within the time limit prescribed therein, the Borough authorities may proceed immediately to clear all snow and/or ice from the sidewalk of such delinquents, and to collect the expenses thereof, with any additional amount allowed by law, from such owner, occupant or tenant, as the case may be, which may be in addition to any fine or penalty imposed under the third section of this ordinance.

SECTION 3. Penalty for Violation. Any owner, occupant or tenant who shall fail to remove any snow or ice from any sidewalk or walkway as required by the first section of this ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof, be sentenced to a fine of not more than twenty-five (\$25.00) Dollars, and costs of prosecution, and, in default of payment of such fine and costs, to imprisonment for not more than twenty-five (25) days. Provided such

fine and costs of prosecution may be in addition to any expenses and additional amounts authorized by law, imposed as provided in the second section of this ordinance.
