ORDINANCE

An Ordinance prohibiting parking of unhitched vehicles.

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Board of Yoe Borough Council, York County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby enacted and ordained as follows:

Section 1: PARKING PROHIBITED.

The parking of a trailer, semi-trailer, boat, mobile home, or camper of any kind, when the same is not attached to a tractor or motor vehicle upon any of the streets, alleys or highways of the Borough of Yoe is hereby prohibited.

Section 2: SEPARATE OFFENSES.

Each day that any person shall park a trailer or semi-trailer in violation of the provisions of this Article shall be considered a separate and distinct offense.

Section 3: VEHICLE AS LIVING QUARTERS.

No person shall, within Yoe Borough occupy, reside in, or use as living quarters any vehicle, including trailers, semi-trailers, or campers.

Section 4: LEASE OF VEHICLE AS LIVING QUARTERS.

No person, whether as owner or agent, shall lease to or permit the use of by any person any vehicle including trailers or semi-trailers, or campers, as living quarters within the Borough of Yoe.

Section 5: PENALTIES.

Any operator, owner, person in possession, custody, or control of any vehicle described in this ordinance who violates any provisions of this ordinance shall upon conviction before any district magistrate justice, justice of the peace, or court of competent jurisdiction of Yoe Borough shall be sentenced to pay a fine of not less than \$25.00 and not more than \$100.00 and costs of prosecution, and in default of payment thereof shall be imprisoned in the York County jail for a period of not less

than five days and not more than fifteen days.
