ORDINANCE

An Ordinance expressing desire for a question to be placed on April election ballot to increase debt for Yoe Borough for recreation purposes.

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Board of Yoe Borough Council, York County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby enacted and ordained as follows:

The following question shall be placed on the ballot for purposes of a referendum at the election on April 27, 1976.

"Shall debt not to exceed a total of Ten thousand (\$10,000.00) dollars after deducting donations for the purpose of financing the erecting and maintaining recreation facilities on donated land be authorized to be incurred as debt approved by the electors?"
