AN ORDINANCE

OF THE BOROUGH OF YOE, YORK COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA,
ESTABLISHING WATER RATES, RENTS AND CHARGES FOR
FURNISHING WATER SERVICE TO CONSUMERS LOCATED IN
THIS BOROUGH; PROVIDING FOR PAYMENT OF SUCH WATER
RATES, RENTS AND CHARGES; AND PROVIDING FOR
PENALTIES ON ALL DELINQUENT PAYMENTS.

The Council of the Borough of Yoe, York County,
Pennsylvania, hereby ordains and enacts as follows:

SECTION 1: RATES FOR WATER SERVICE.

The following rates for water service to consumers
located in this Borough are adopted by the Borough:

<u>A. Schedule of Meter Rates</u>	<u>Per 1,000 Gallons</u>
First 3,000 gallons/quarter	\$3.12
Next 2,000 gallons/quarter	1.95
Next 5,000 gallons/quarter	1.56
Next 10,000 gallons/quarter	1.04
Next 10,000 gallons/quarter	.91
All over 30,000 gallons/quarter	.77

B. PUBLIC FIRE PROTECTION.

For each standard fire hydrant, per quarter \$11.38.

C. PRIVATE FIRE PROTECTION.

For a six (6) inch or less connection
to the street main, per quarter \$14.63

For an eight (8) inch connection to
the street main, per quarter 29.25

For a ten (10) inch connection to
the street main, per quarter 52.00

D. WATER USED FOR BUILDING PURPOSES.

A \$6.50 minimum for 1,500 square feet of floor space,
and a proportionate amount for additional floor space.

All metered customers shall be subject to a quarterly minimum charge based on the required size of meter to render adequate service, as follows:

Size of Meter	Per Quarter	
	Minimum	Allowance
5/8-inch to 3/4-inch	\$ 9.36	3,000
1 inch	13.26	5,000
1-1/2-inch	26.26	15,000
2-inch	40.56	30,000
3-inch	78.26	90,000
4-inch	139.75	200,000
6-inch	251.55	400,000
8-inch	419.25	700,000

The customers shall pay the minimum charge even though the amount resulting by applying the meter rate to the quantity of water consumed is less than the minimum charge. When such amount is greater than said minimum charge, then the greater amount shall constitute the bill for service rendered.

SECTION 2: PAYMENT PERIOD.

The rates established herein shall be payable quarterly. The charges imposed constitute the net bill. If water rentals or charges are not paid within twenty (20) calendar days after each quarterly billing date, an additional sum of five (5%) per cent for each quarter or part thereof that the bill remains unpaid shall be added to such net bill. Payment made or mailed and postmarked on or before the last day of said twenty (20) calendar day period shall constitute the payment within such period. If the end of such twenty (20) calendar day period shall fall on a legal holiday or Sunday, payment made or mailed and postmarked on the next succeeding weekday which is not a legal holiday shall constitute payment within such period.

SECTION 3: EFFECTIVE DATE AND APPLICABILITY.

The rate schedule herein established shall be charged on all billings on or after June 1, 1977. Presently established rates shall remain effective for all billings rendered prior to June 1, 1977.

SECTION 4: REPEALER.

All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent with this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.
