

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE ADOPTION
OF WEST NEWTON ALLEY FROM CHERRY ALLEY TO
WALNUT STREET, WEST PHILADELPHIA STREET
FROM CHERRY ALLEY TO WALNUT STREET, WEST
WEST THIRD STREET FROM CHERRY ALLEY TO
WALNUT STREET AND WEST FOURTH STREET FROM
CHERRY ALLEY TO WALNUT, OF THE BOROUGH OF
YOE, YORK COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA.

An ordinance providing for the adoption of West Newton Alley from Cherry Alley to Walnut Street, West Philadelphia street from Cherry Alley to Walnut Street, West Third street from Cherry Alley to Walnut Street and West Fourth Street from Cherry Alley to Walnut, of the Borough of Yoe, York County, Pennsylvania, as public highways of said Borough of Yoe, as now laid out on a plan or plot of said Borough of Yoe.

SECTION 1. Be it enacted and ordained by the chief burgess and town council of the borough of Yoe, York County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by authority of the same:

That West Newton Alley of said borough of Yoe be and the same is hereby adopted as a public highway of said borough of Yoe, of the uniform width of sixteen feet, the following courses and distances: Beginning for the center thereof in the center of Cherry Alley, and extending thence, north, eighty degrees, seven minutes, west, one hundred and fifty-seven feet to the center of Walnut Street of said borough of Yoe.

SECTION 2. That West Philadelphia Street of said borough of Yoe be and the same is hereby adopted as a public highway of said borough of Yoe, of the uniform width of forty feet from building line to building line, and thirty feet from curb line to curb line, the following courses and distances; beginning for the center thereof in the center of Cherry Alley, and extending thence north, seventy-nine degrees, thirty-two minutes, west, one hundred and seventy-three and seventenths feet to the center of Walnut street of said borough of Yoe.

SECTION 3. That West Third Street of said borough of Yoe be and the same is hereby adopted as a public highway of said borough of Yoe, of the uniform width of forty feet from building line to building line, and thirty feet from curb line to curb line, the following courses and distances; Beginning for the center thereof in the center of Cherry Alley and extending thence, north, seventy-nine degrees, thirty-two minutes, west, one hundred and seventy-seven and two-tenths feet to the center of Walnut Street of said borough of Yoe.

SECTION 4. That West Fourth Street of said borough of Yoe be and the same is hereby adopted as a public highway of said borough of Yoe, of the uniform width of forty feet from building line to building line, and thirty feet from curb line to curb line, the following courses and distances: Beginning for the center thereof in the center of Cherry Street, and extending thence, north, seventy-nine degrees, thirty-two minutes, west, one hundred and eighty and three-tenths feet to the center of Walnut Street of said borough of Yoe.
