ORDINANCE

An Ordinance amending Ordinance 17-1894 Regulating Taxation in the Borough of Yoe, Section 1.

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Board of Yoe Borough Council, York County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby enacted and ordained as follows:

WHEREAS, the Borough Council intends and desires to amend and modify Section 1 to read as follows:

SECTION 1: Be enacted and ordained by the Board of Yoe Borough Council, York County, Pennsylvania, and is hereby enacted and ordained by authority of the same, that from and after the passage of this ordinance, the town council of the said borough shall, annually, designate by resolution the tax rate to be imposed for the ensuing use or any regular or special meeting of Borough Council held in the month of December; they shall also designate the time and place for hearing appeals against such taxation, and shall give due notice thereof either by bills or by such other means as may be authorized by the said council. This provision shall not apply to the municipal service fee imposed under authority of Ordinance 78-002.

All other sections in Ordinance No. 17-1894 shall remain with the same full force and effect.
