ORDINANCE

An Ordinance amending the Sewer Ordinance C-73-006 and 74-001 by authorizing additional materials for pipe used for building sewer lines connecting with Yoe Borough Sewer System.

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Board of Yoe Borough Council, York County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby enacted and ordained as follows:

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 73-006 was enacted September 25, 1973;

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 74-001 was enacted January 2, 1974;

WHEREAS, the Yoe Borough Council intends and desires to amend and modify Section 3.06 to read as follows:

SECTION 3.06. A Building Sewer shall be connected to a Sewer at the place designated by this Borough of the Authority and where the lateral is provided.

The invert of a Building Sewer at the point of connection shall be at the same or a higher elevation than the invert of the Sewer. A smooth, neat joint shall be made and the connection of a Building Sewer to the lateral shall be made secure and watertight.

1. The plumbing code known as the "BOCA" Code is adopted in its entirety, excepting as herein modified and all building sewers shall conform to said code except as herein modified.

2. Pipe used for building sewers shall conform to one of the following materials:

a. Cast iron soil pipe conforming to ASA-A40.1.

b. Class 1500 asbestos-cement sewer pipe with pre moulded couplings and rubber gaskets.

c. Pipe and fittings shall be made from PVC plastic per ASTM D-3034:

1) Installation: pipe and fittings shall be installed in accordance with ASTM D-2321 and ASTM D-2855;

2) Joints: Joints shall be elastomeric gasket joints per ASTM D-3034:

3) Type: Shall be Type PSM-PVC pipe and shall be SDR-33.5 for 4" diameter and SDR-35 for 6" through 12" diameter.

The owner shall furnish and install an appropriate adapter to connect the building sewer onto the lateral. The owner should make sure that adequate traps and vents are installed in the building sewer and interior plumbing to prevent potentially dangerous sewer gases from entering any structure of the Improved Property.

All other sections of Ordinance No. 73-006 shall remain with the same full force and effect.

ALL OTHER SECTIONS OF ORDINANCE 73-006 SHALL REMAIN WITH THE SAME FULL FORCE AND EFFECT.
