ORDINANCE

An Ordinance prohibiting specific conduct in designated recreation areas of the Borough.

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Board of Yoe Borough Council, York County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby enacted and ordained as follows:

Section 1.

The following terms as used in this Ordinance shall be defined as follows:

1. Recreation areas shall include all the following premises owned by the Borough of Yoe and used for parks or recreational purposes:

A. Yoe Ball Field, located on the west side of Maple Street, between West High Street and Yoe Drive.

B. Yoe Borough Recreation Area, the tennis courts and surrounding recreation area located on East Philadelphia Street, in the Borough of Yoe.

2. Trespass, the presence of any individual, except on duty police officers and other elected or appointed Borough officials on the premises designated as recreation areas, above defined, from 10:00 p.m. until 6:30 a.m. the following morning during daylight savings time and from 8:00 p.m. until 6:30 a.m. the next morning during eastern standard time.

Section 2.

The following conduct shall be prohibited within all recreation areas as defined in Section 1.

1. It shall be unlawful to bring onto the recreation area alcoholic beverages or to consume alcoholic beverages while on the premises.

2. It shall be unlawful for any individual to trespass on the recreation area.

3. It shall be unlawful for any individual who has not been authorized by a municipal official to drive a motor vehicle on the premises of a recreation area except on those portions of a recreation area which may be designated as parking areas.

Section 3.

Any person who shall violate any of the terms or provisions of this

Ordinance, shall, upon conviction thereof, be sentenced to pay a fine not exceeding \$300.00, all costs of prosecution, all damage to municipal property resulting from their violation of the Ordinance, and to imprisonment in York County Prison for a period not to exceed 30 days.

Section 4.

If any provision of this Ordinance or the application thereof to any person or any circumstances is held invalid, the remainder of this Ordinance and the application of such provision to other persons or circumstances shall not be effected thereby and to this and the provisions of this Ordinance are declared to be severable.

Section 5.

All Ordinances or part of Ordinances inconsistent herewith be and the same are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

Section 6.

This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon enactment.
