ORDINANCE

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE C-73-007, SECTION 3, SUB-SECTIONS A., B., AND C. INCREASING SEWER RENTAL RATES TO BE CHARGED BY THE BOROUGH OF YOE TO PROPERTY OWNERS FOR THE USE OF THE SEWER SYSTEM.

BE IT ESTABLISHED AND ORDAINED by the Borough Council of Yoe Borough, York County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by the Authority of the same as follows:

SECTION I

This Ordinance shall be known as the "Yoe Borough Sewer Rate Ordinance".

SECTION II

As of the effective date of this Ordinance the rate charged to owners of property in Yoe Borough for the use of the Yoe Borough Sewer System for each domestic use, apartment, or office use, shall be Two Hundred and Forty (\$240.00) Dollars per annum, payable at the rate of Sixty (\$60.00) Dollars per quarterly billing period.

SECTION III

As of the effective date of this Ordinance the minimum rate charged to owners of property in Yoe Borough for the use of the Yoe Borough Sewer System for commercial or industrial use, shall be Two Hundred and Forty (\$240.00) Dollars per annum, payable at the rate of Sixty (\$60.00) Dollars per quarterly billing period.

SECTION IV

A charge of Fifty (\$50.00) Dollars per quarter shall be charged to any property owner for any property for which there is an inflow or infiltration into the sanitary sewer system. The charge shall be made after notice of such condition by the Borough to the property owner and the failure of the property owner to correct the situation within thirty (30) days from the date of such notice. Such notice may be made by ordinary, first class, United States mail to the address of the owner most recently supplied to the Sewer Authority by that owner.

SECTION V

The provisions of this Ordinance shall be effective August 15, 1986, and the sewer rate increases called for herein shall be applicable to the sewer quarter commencing August 15, 1986, and every quarter thereafter.

SECTION VI

Any prior Ordinance or parts of Ordinances inconsistent with this Ordinance are hereby repealed.
