ORDINANCE

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 85-002 ESTABLISHING AND CONFIRMING THE PLACEMENT OF STOP SIGNS ON PUBLIC STREETS WITHIN THE BOROUGH OF YOE.

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Borough of Yoe Council, York County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby enacted and ordained as follows:

SECTION I

Section 1 of Ordinance No. 85-002 is amended to include the placement of stop signs at the following intersections:

Elm Street at the intersection of Third Street.

SECTION II

This Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its passage.
