ORDINANCE

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 71-004 PROHIBITING CERTAIN VEHICLES FROM USING BROAD STREET, WALNUT STREET, AND A PORTION OF ELM STREET.

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Borough of Yoe Council, York County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby enacted and ordained as follows:

SECTION I

Ordinance No. 86-004, Section 1, which amends Ordinance No. 71-004, Section 1, is amended as follows:

It shall be unlawful for any person to operate any vehicle with a gross vehicle weight of 12,000 pounds, or greater, on Broad Street between Main Street and Orchard Street, on Elm Street from Philadelphia north to Walnut Street, and Walnut Street from Elm Street west to the Borough limits, all in the Borough of Yoe, York County, Pennsylvania.

SECTION II

This Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its passage.

SECTION III

Any Ordinance or part thereof inconsistent herewith is hereby repealed except Section 3, Ordinance 71-004.
