ORDINANCE

AN ORDINANCE LAYING OUT AND ADOPTING WEST WALNUT STREET, EAST AND WEST THIRD STREET, WEST FOURTH STREET, EAST AND WEST PHILADELPHIA STREET, AND EAST WATER STREET IN THE BOROUGH OF YOE, YORK COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA.

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Borough of Yoe Council, York County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby enacted and ordained as follows:

SECTION I

That the hereinafter named streets in Yoe Borough be laid out and adopted as follows:

- a) West Walnut Street: Beginning at a point on the centreline of South Maple Street, and extending thence North thirty-two (32) degrees thirty-one (31) minutes three (03) seconds West a distance of nine hundred twenty-seven and ninety-four hundredths (927.94) feet to a point on the centreline of Orchard Street, having a cartway width of twenty-nine and five tenths (29.5) feet and a uniform right-of-way width of forty (40) feet.
- b) East Third Street: Beginning at a point on the centreline of Main Street and extending thence South seventy-eight (78) degrees three (03) minutes thirty (30) seconds East a distance of one hundred seventy-one and four tenths (171.4) feet to a point on the centreline of Park Avenue, having a cartway width of twenty (20) feet and a uniform right-of-way width of forty (40) feet.
- c) West Third Street: Beginning at a point on the centreline of Main Street, and extending thence North seventy-eight (78) degrees forty-seven (47) minutes twenty-six (26) seconds East a distance of one hundred seventy-six and three tenths (176.3) feet to a point on the centreline of Fern Avenue, having a cartway width of twenty-nine and two tenths (29.2) feet and a uniform right-of-way width of forty (40) feet.

- d) West Fourth Street: Beginning at a point on the centreline of Main Street and extending thence North seventy-three (73) degrees forty-four (44) minutes fifty-one (51) seconds West a distance of one hundred seventy-eight (178) feet to a point on the centreline of Fern Avenue, having a cartway width of twenty-seven (27) feet and a uniform right-of-way width of forty (40) feet.
- e) East Philadelphia Street: Beginning at a point on the centreline of Main Street and extending thence North seventy-eight (78) degrees thirty-three (33) minutes two (02) seconds West a distance of one hundred eighty (180) feet to a point on the centreline of Park Avenue, having a cartway width of thirty (30) feet and a uniform right-of-way width of forty (40) feet.
- f) West Philadelphia Street: Beginning at a point on the centreline of Main Street and extending thence South seventy-eight (78) degrees thirty (30) minutes forty-one (41) seconds East, a distance of one hundred seventy-seven (177) feet to a point on the centreline of Fern Avenue, having a cartway width of thirty and five tenths (30.5) feet and a uniform right-of-way width of forty (40) feet.
- g) East Water Street: Beginning at a point on the centreline of Main Street and extending thence South fifty-eight (58) degrees twenty-three (23) minutes forty (40) seconds East, a distance of one hundred eighty-three and seven tenths (183.7) feet to a point on the centreline of Church Street, having a cartway width varying from sixteen and five tenths (16.5) feet to twenty (20) feet and a uniform right-of-way width of forty (40) feet.

SECTION II

This Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its passage.
