ORDINANCE

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 85-002 AS MORE RECENTLY AMENDED, ESTABLISHING THE PLACEMENT OF STOP SIGNS ON PUBLIC STREETS WITHIN THE BOROUGH OF YOE.

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Borough of Yoe Council, York County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby enacted and ordained as follows:

SECTION I

Section I of Ordinance No. 85-002 as amended is hereby further amended to include the placement of stop signs at the following intersections:

Mason Avenue at the intersection of West Broad Street for North and South bound traffic.

Mason Avenue at Water Street for North bound traffic.

Water Street at Mason Avenue for East and West bound traffic.

SECTION II

This Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its passage.
